Find Your Time

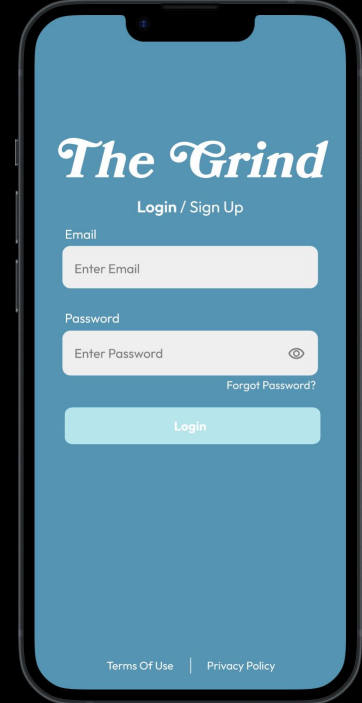

The Grind official app helps students of all ages find time in their schedule to dedicate to studying. The Grind keeps track of assignments, tests, and due dates to help students utilize their time efficiently. When the user opens the app they are prompted to login or sign up for a new account.

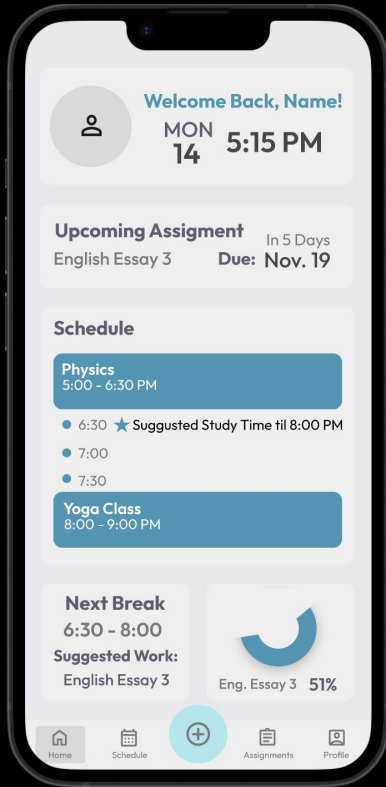
Loading Screen



Login Screen



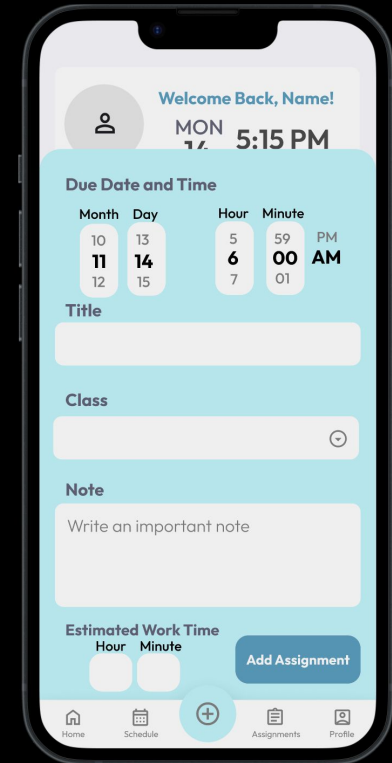
Home Screen



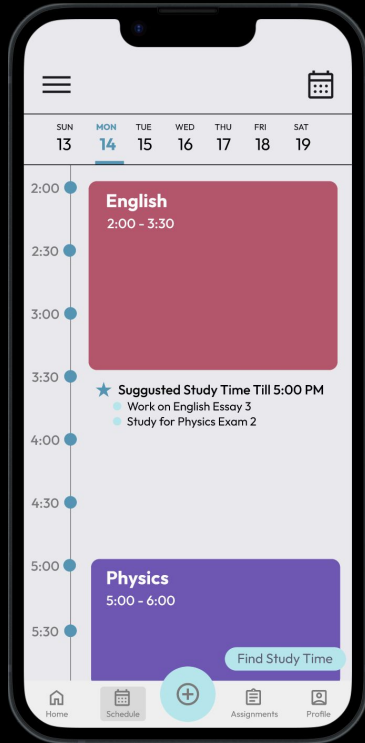
The app opens up to a home screen that highlights the user's profile, a snippet of their current schedule, next due assignment or test, the user's next available break, and an assignment progress tracker.

If the user wants to add an assignment or test to their schedule, the user can press on the blue plus symbol which prompts the user to input the assignment's name, due date, class, added notes, and estimated completion time. The user then presses the Add Assignment button which adds the task to their schedule and suggests times when to work on it.

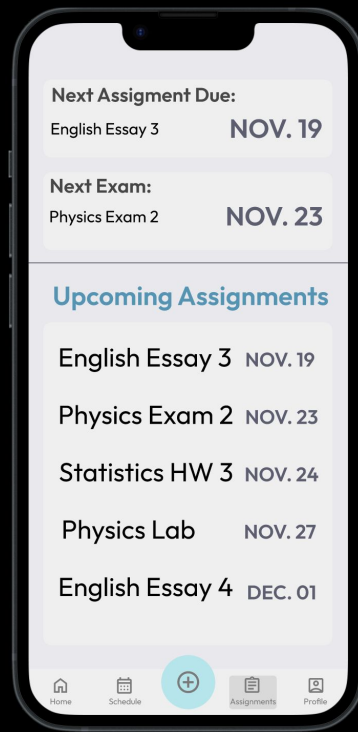
Create an Assignment Pop Up

Users can select the Schedule button to view their full daily schedule. Users can add their events and view daily, weekly, or monthly calendar. When the app detects a time where the user can work on homework, it suggests assignments to work on based on due date.

Users can view and track their assignments if they select the Assignments tab. It highlights the users next upcoming assignment and test, and lists all their work with their due dates.

Users can select the Profile button to access multiple settings. Users can edit their profile username and photo, access app settings, add other The Grind users, view past assignments, app activity and account settings, and have the ability to remove ads with The Grind Pro version.

The Grind has a Pro version for \$2 a month, which allows users to create group calendars by linking other users schedules together and allowing users to set multiple schedules.

Ads will run on the free public version while the Pro version is ad free.
